## Training of Strengthening of Federations

Training on the strengthening of the federations was conducted at three clusters- ODP, Mysore on 9th July 2024, KDDC, Karwar on 11th July 2024 and ORBIT, Humnabad on 16th July 2024 with 98 participants. The training focused on the formation and functioning of federations. Notable speakers Mrs. Laina. V. Lasrado, Program Coordinator, WEP,Mr. Jagadish, Coordinator, SMSSS, Mr. Styanly Fernandes, Coordinator, Sampada, Mr. Harishchandra, Coordinator, KDDC spoke on the key topics such as the roles and norms of SHG's, the definition and purpose of a federation, and guidelines on how a federation should operate. # Cluster level trainings on Communication & Effective listening

In August 2024, a series of cluster-level training programs on Communication and Effective Listening were successfully held across four regions, reaching 168 women participants. The sessions, conducted in SAMPADA, Udupi; MSSS, Badravathi; JVSSS, Mandya; and BDSSS, Dharawada, focused on enhancing essential communication skills through engaging discussions, group activities, and personalized action plans. These trainings aimed to empower women with practical tools to improve their personal and professional interactions while fostering a supportive community among diverse federations.









#### **Orientation on SAFE to Point Persons**

On July 19, 2024, KROSS hosted a pivotal orientation on SaFE (Safeguarding) for key representatives from partner organizations. The event, inaugurated by Rev. Fr. Richard Pais, Director of KROSS, and attended by Rev. Fr. Vincent D'Souza of CODP, brought together 12 participants from 10 partner organizations. The session featured an informative presentation by Ms. Monica Rachel A., KROSS Documentation Officer, on the fundamentals of safeguarding, followed by a practical session led by Mr. Salvadore Pereira, SaFE Program Coordinator. The day concluded with an overview of KROSS's safeguarding policy by the Director, underscoring its critical importance. The event was rounded off with a vote of thanks, acknowledging the active participation and valuable contributions of all involved.





## Women Empowerment-Review Meeting

The Review Meeting for the Women Empowerment Program took place on June 11-12, 2024, at KROSS, Bangalore. The event began with a prayer and a welcoming address by Rev. Fr. Richard Pais, Director of KROSS, and included contributions from Rev. Fr. Leo Alex and Rev. Fr. Rajesh. The first day featured report presentations from 14 DSSS program coordinators, with discussions on future strategies led by Mrs. Bhagya Mary. The second day focused on evaluating the first year of the WEP, with group assessments led by Mrs. Laina Lasrado and action plans presented by Sr. Nancy Lobo. The meeting concluded with final evaluations by Sr. Nancy and a note of appreciation from Mr. Ramesh, highlighting the importance of collaboration and collective learning.





## **SAMRUDI- Monitoring Visit**

In August 2024, the SAMRUDI monitoring team conducted visits to partner organizations, including SSDS in Kalaburgi, Orbit in Humnabad, and DKRDS in Belthangady.
